# P7141 EMERGENCY CHANGE ORDERS TO CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS BOARD POLICY:

In an emergency situation, a change order to a construction contract that will increase the contract amount may be executed without prior Board of Education approval.

Administrative Implemental Procedures:

#### 1. Definition.

An emergency situation shall be defined as one in which failure to act immediately shall cause a delay in the execution of the contract.

#### 2. Limitations.

The Division Director of Facilities may authorize the issuance of a change order in an emergency situation in an amount not to exceed \$7,500, or an amount not to exceed \$10,000 with the approval of the Superintendent of Schools.

## 3. Change orders in excess of \$5,000.

The Superintendent of Schools shall inform Board members as early as possible when an emergency change order in excess of \$5,000 has been approved.

### 4. Report to the Board.

The nature and reasons for the emergency change order approval shall be reported to the Board on the next Board meeting agenda.
