P1389 CONCEALED OBSERVATIONS

BOARD POLICY:

Students and employees are not to be audio or video taped or photographed by the use of concealed devices without the prior approval of the Superintendent.

Administrative Implemental Procedures:

- 1. Teachers are not to be monitored by intercom or other mechanical or electronic devices without their knowledge and permission.
- 2. Any plan to make an audio or video recording of or to photograph students or employees by use of a concealed recorder or camera must have the prior approval of the Superintendent.
- 3. Generally, plans to use a concealed recorder or camera to record or to photograph students or employees for promotional purposes will not be approved.
- 4. Disclosure of any audio or video recording or photograph of students must be done in compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), 20 U.S.C. § 1232g, as amended, and its interpretive regulations, 34 C.F.R. § 99.1, et seq.
