Kensler School Wide Discipline Plan

Kensler utilizes CHAMPS (Conversation-Help-Activity-Movement-Participation-Success) as a building-wide approach to behavior management. CHAMPS encourages students to be good role models for their peers. All classroom teachers will attempt to keep parents informed about positive experiences with their students as well as concerns with academics/behavior.

Any guns/weapons (toy or real), fighting, inappropriate language or gestures, gang activity, willful destruction of property and harassment of any kind will be dealt with according to district and state policies. Parents will be contacted immediately if any of these behaviors are displayed. Individual contracts may be used for students who consistently choose inappropriate behaviors. Parental support is necessary to reinforce students' positive behavior at school. Board Policy 1464 states: "Each Pupil is held responsible for his/her personal actions. The right to attend a Wichita Public School carries with it the obligation to maintain acceptable behavior."
