



Student/Parent Agreement Form

Excel in CTE Initiative (formerly SB 155)

The Governor of Kansas approved juniors and seniors to access college credit classes that prepare students to work in high demand career fields at NO CHARGE through the Excel in Career and Technical Education (CTE) formerly known as SB 155. This opportunity will assist students in acquiring work ready skills while building a college transcript and contribute to a skilled workforce for Kansas employers. Without paying a penny in tuition, students are eligible to take qualified career and technical college credit courses offered through Wichita State University Tech (WSU Tech).

I understand that:

- CTE courses are free to student, but the student is responsible for the cost of required materials (books, tools, special clothing, etc...)
- Student must have a high school GPA of at least 2.0
- Student must have an excellent high school attendance record.
- Student must be in good academic standing (be on track for graduation).
- If the student fails the CTE course or has to drop out for any reason, he/she will not receive college credit, nor will they receive high school credit.
- If the student fails the CTE course or has to drop out for any reason, the student's financial aid (FASFA) may be in jeopardy for when they enter college full time.
- **Students are responsible for attending WSU Tech classes on in-service days, or when USD 259 does not hold classes if WSU Tech is in session.**
- When WSU Tech classes are canceled, the student is to come to Chester Lewis ONLY for their classes at Wichita Alternative High School. Students need to be off campus at the time WSU Tech classes are held.
- **Students and parents are responsible for obtaining grades and attendance information for WSU Tech classes.**
- Student and parents are responsible for communicating with their Chester Lewis counselor and their WSU Tech advisor.
