Speak Up, the 100% anonymous tip program coordinated through the Wichita Public Schools' Safety and Environmental Services Department, and in partnership with Crime Stoppers of Wichita and Sedgwick County, a Division of the Wichita Crime Commission, will now be accepting tips by phone, the web, and the free P3 Tips mobile app .

How do I submit a tip?

To submit a tip on your smart phone, just download the P3 Tips app from the App Store or Google Play and follow the onscreen prompts.



Are there other ways to submit tips?

What happens after I submit a tip?

When tips are received by the Speak Up Coordinator they are forwarded (electronically), on a daily basis, to the designated contact person(s) at each school site. If the tip requires immediate attention, the information will immediately go to school officials (and law enforcement agencies, as appropriate.) Once tips are received by the school's contact, they will investigate, take action as needed and complete a disposition form.
