Do you feel sick, have a cold or the flu? Well here is what you need to do...

As the cold and flu season is upon us, please remember to keep your students home when they are sick to help avoid spreading illness. If your child has a fever (temperature of 100.4 or above) he or she needs to remain home until they have been fever free without any medication (Tylenol, Ibuprofen, etc.) for 24 hours before returning to school per USD 259 district policy. Your child should remain home if they are not feeling well enough to fully participate in regular school activities or if they display "flu-like" symptoms (cough, headache, fatigue, body aches, vomiting and / or diarrhea with or without a fever.) Persons diagnosed with influenza/flu shall remain on home isolation for 5 days following onset of symptoms or until fever-free without fever reducing medications for 24 hours, whichever is LONGER.

Drop-off and Pick-up Reminder

- For morning drop-off, they must be brought through the drop-off lane and **NOT** dropped off at the end of the bus lane. Please enter the drop-off lane via 53rd street and proceed to door 28. Drop-off for breakfast is 8:30 and all other students may enter at 8:50.
- The doors will be closing at 9:00am sharp and students will have to enter through door number 1.
- When picking students up make sure that you are pulling all the way forward to the car in front of you and be ready to receive your student.
- **Also, make sure that students and parents are using the crosswalk when crossing to other parking areas.**

Magnet Info

Incoming siblings of Isely magnet students for the 2020-21 school year will need to apply for magnet placement. Siblings that live outside our neighborhood boundary will need to complete the magnet application in order to apply to attend Isely.
