

Absence Notification Reminders

Parents/Guardians of students absent from school are to call the attendance line, 973-8201 by 9:15AM the day of absence. Leave the following info on Voice Mail: identify yourself, students name and grade, date of absence and reason for absence.


Absences are only excused for the following reasons: illness, doctor/dentist appt., family death, court appearance, school sponsored activities and religious observations.

All other absences are unexcused unless approved by principal prior to the absence. This form is located in the family handbook. This form is to be used for any absence longer then 3 days.

DO NOT choose masks that

From the Desk of Nurse Lindsey

1. As a reminder, it is required that all students, staff, and visitors wear a face mask to school each day. The face mask must cover both the individual’s nose and mouth. Please review the graphics, to the , from the CDC website as to which type of masks are appropriate and safe for the school setting.
2. Vision screens were completed for Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 5th grades as well as hearing screens for Kindergarten, 2nd, and 5th grades. If your child does not pass his or her screening, then a referral letter will be sent home with your child. As indicated on the referral letter, please follow up with the recommended provider (eye doctor, medical care provider, or audiologist) in a timely manner to address the needs of your child’s vision or hearing. Once seen by provider, then please return the completed referral letter to the school nurse.
