7241 Introduction to Transportation

A semester long introductory course designed to provide students with knowledge of occupations available in the field of automotive collision and technician. Class will include many hands-on demonstrations and the opportunity to move on to more advanced level courses.

7223-7224 Auto Collision 1

A year long course that will allow students to begin using the knowledge acquired in 7241. In this course students will work on real life projects and possibly have the opportunity to move on to more advanced level courses.

7225-7226 Auto Collision 2

The second of two courses designed to provide students with the skills and knowledge necessary to be prepared to work in the field of automotive collision. In this course students will work on real life projects and possibly have the opportunity to move on to more advanced level courses.

7249F-7250F Auto Refinishing 1&2 (++)

A year long course designed to provide students with knowledge needed to work in highly specialized areas of auto collision. In this course students will work on real life projects and possibly have the opportunity to move on to more advanced level courses.

7230 Custom Refinishing & Applications A

The first of two courses that will allow students to begin using the knowledge acquired in 7249F-7250F. In this course students will work on real life custom refinishing projects.

7231 Custom Refinishing & Applications B

The second of two courses that will allow students to continue using the knowledge acquired in 7249F-7250F. In this course students will work on real life custom refinishing projects.
