5663- 5664	Chinese 1 This course is designed to introduce the Chinese language and culture. It acquaints students with listening, speaking, reading and writing skills and aspects of Chinese culture.	None	9-10-11-12
5665- 5666	Chinese 2 This course is designed to continue the development of skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing.	Chinese 1	10-11-12
5651- 5652	Chinese 3 This course is designed to continue the development of skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing. Students will also deepen their understanding of Chinese thought and culture.	Chinese 2	11-12
5653- 5654	Chinese 4 This course is a continuation and refinement of skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. There will be an emphasis on using the langue in future work and study and on understanding aspects of Chinese history, art, writing, thought and daily life.	Chinese 3	12
5411- 5412	Spanish 1 This course is designed as an introduction to Hispanic culture and the Spanish language. It acquaints the students with listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills while looking at Hispanic culture and geographical aspects of Spanish-speaking regions. The emphasis is on listening and speaking.	None	9-10-11-12
5421- 5422	Spanish 2 This course is designed to continue the listening, speaking, reading, writing, and cultural activities. There is an emphasis on reading, writing, and culture.	Spanish 1	9-10-11-12
5431- 5432	Spanish 3 Spanish will be used as the language of instruction in this course. Oral communication will continue to be stressed, with more of the responsibility for class presentations resting with the students. Students will study Hispanic literature and give oral and written reports in Spanish.	Spanish 2	10-11-12

5441-5442	Spanish 4 Spanish will be used as the language of instruction in this course. Increased proficiency in all four skills is the goal, with continued emphasis on the culture of Spanish-speaking countries.	Spanish 3	11-12
5451-5452	Spanish 5 Spanish will be used as the language of instruction in this course. Increased proficiency in all four skills is the goal, with continued emphasis on research into literature of various Spanish-speaking countries.	Spanish 4	12
5485-5486	Spanish for Native Speakers 1 This class is designed for students already possessing fluent oral language but desiring to improve their reading and writing skills in their native language.	Fluent oral language speaker	9-10-11-12
5487-5488	Spanish for Native Speakers 2 This class is designed to continue improving the reading and writing skills of students who have fluent oral language in their native language.	Spanish for Native Speakers 1	10-11-12
5489-5490	Spanish for Native Speakers 3 This class is designed for students already possessing <u>fluent</u> oral language but desiring to improve their reading and writing skills in their native language.	Spanish for Native Speakers 2	11-12
