

Robinson PTSO Meeting Minutes – October 13, 2020

Meeting called to order on Microsoft Teams: 7:05 p.m.

- I. Introductions
  - A. Jesse Milne welcomed all in attendance and thanked so many people for joining in on Microsoft teams.
  
- II. Approval of Minutes
  - A. PTSO – Rebecca Snell made a motion to accept the minutes from March 2020, that was seconded by Abe. The motion passed unanimously.
  
- III. Financial Report: Rebecca Snell, Treasurer, noted that we had no activity in the past month. The current bank balance is \$8,417.85.
  
- IV. Officer positions to fill: Jesse Milne noted that we still need a Vice President and Secretary and Volunteer Coordinator. Mr. Freund said he could send out a parent link to 6<sup>th</sup> grade parents to see if we could get some interest.
  
- V. Confirmation of proposed 2020-21 meeting dates
  - A. Jesse Milne shared that meetings will held on the 2nd Tuesday of each month with Foundation beginning at 6:00 p.m. and PTSO beginning at 7:00 p.m.
  
- VI. New Business
  - A. Jesse Milne asked for ideas of what PTSO could do if students get to return in November. Abe Rodriguez suggested a socially distanced welcoming tunnel of parents and other volunteers cheering the kids on as they come back to school (with masks on) and hold signs with encouraging sayings. Abe will work with Ashten Anderson and coordinate with Mr. Freund.
  - B. Meal for teacher conferences. PTSO will provide a meal one night of teacher conferences. Even though conferences will be remote, the teachers will probably be working at least one night. Mr. Freund will coordinate with Jesse with the date and Jesse will build a google form for teachers to choose their meal from Jimmy Johns. Abes said he can secure PTSO a 40% discount from Jimmy Johns. The meal will then be delivered to the school by Jimmy Johns.
  
- VII. Other Items:
  - A. Jesse then asked for any other items and encouraged all in attendance to contact him if they had any questions regarding PTSO.
  - B. Rebecca gave a brief synopsis of PTSO does for the school during a non-covid year describing the 6<sup>th</sup> grade mixer hosted at back to school, the fall dance, the Achieve-a-thon/staff encounter fund raiser in the fall, the spring dance, incentives for honor roll achievers, teacher conference meals,
