Attendance Days	Students with last names beginning with A-L will attend onsite Monday and Tuesday. Those with last names M-Z will attend onsite on Thursday and Friday.
Health Check	Every student should complete a self-screening questionnaire before coming to school, including taking their temperature. Students attending onsite should not have a temperature higher than 100.4F, feel ill or exhibit any illness symptoms. If students have symptoms of, have tested positive for, or are awaiting test results for COVID-19, the SHOULD NOT GO to school. Parents should call the student's school to report a COVID-related absence.

Re-entry Logistics

- Students will enter three different doors based on grade level
 - 6th Grade Door#2
 - 7th Grade Door #1
 - 8th Grade Door #10
- Students that want breakfast can grab and go with the breakfast taking it to first hour.
- Parent please do not drop your student off before 7:45am each morning.
- 1st hour teachers will be expected to be in their rooms at 7:50am to greet students daily.
- Students will eat their breakfast and complete either second step lessons or character education activities and team builders. Students will carry any coats or other belongings to all their classes.
- All grade level students are in a pod area so classes are in close proximity so there is no passing period just a transition time from one class to the next. No restroom breaks.
- Teachers will greet students and provide hand sanitizer as the students enter the class. At the end of each class the class will take time to sanitize their work area before they move to the next class. Each classroom will have cleaning supplies.
- Bathroom breaks will be during class, each teacher will have a sign-out, and sign-in provided by the teacher.
- Anytime a student is required to leave the room for ANY reasons there is a digital contact form they will fill out electronically.
- All persons in the building will wear mask the entire day.
- End of the day dismissal will be a staggered release times
 - Mixed abilities
 - Bus riders
 - 6th grade
 - 8th grade
 - 7th grade

Supplies

We will not be using lockers this school year. We want to minimize the amount of supplies needed since all instruction will continue to be computer based

The following supplies will be provided by Hadley to all Face 2 Face students free of charge:

- Chromebook/iPad
- Laptop Bag
- A face mask
- Supply Kit (Notebook with paper, mechanical pencils, pens, highlighters) There is no reason for students to share supplies.

Students will need the following supplies:

- Face covering that covers both the nose and mouth
- Small personal bottle of hand sanitizer
- A fully charged Chromebook and charger each day
- Earphones (Preferably noise canceling with built in microphone)
- Clear see through water bottle (We have water bottle filling stations but no regular fountains)
- Hadley Backpack (OPTIONAL) \$20 in the office, since we are not using lockers students can care their backpacks and they don't have to be Hadley backpacks but those are preferred along with the laptop bags given by check and connect teachers.
