All IB parents are welcome to attend monthly meetings during the school year. They are typically held the first Thursday of each month at 6:30 p.m. in the East High Hangar.

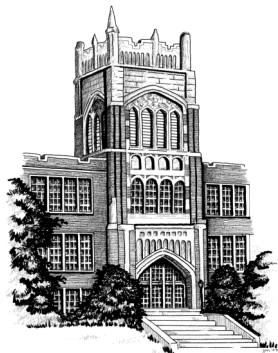
All IB parents are part of IBPA and may fully participate in meetings.
