WPS DATA

- Positive COVID-19 cases (current as of 11-27-20)
 - **Staff: 334**
- Staff under quarantine (current as of 11-27-20)
 - **Staff: 1,137 active quarantines**
(16% of workforce)
 - **22 schools have 20%+ staff quarantined**

WPS RESPONSE

- Sub/guest staff supply can't keep up with demand
- Specials teachers, paraprofessionals are filling in classroom positions
- Certified central office staff have been in the field teaching in order to try and meet unfilled need
- Currently we have four elementary/ special schools in full remote learning:
 - Levy, Mueller, White and Payne
