Dress Down Guidelines

Occasionally students receive permission to dress down at Mead. On dress down days, students who do not have permission to dress down must arrive in dress code. Students who do have permission to dress down must still dress appropriately for school. Below are guidelines to which students must adhere:

- Any choice of color is allowed on dress down days.
- Jeans, sweatpants, and athletic pants are allowed on dress down days.
- Hooded tops/hoodies are allowed on dress down days.
- No spaghetti strap tops.
- Holes in clothing may not inappropriately reveal bare skin.
- Shorts, skirts, and jumpers may be no higher than 3" above knee. Even if leggings are worn underneath, the shorts, skirts, and jumpers may be no higher than 3" above knee.
- Leggings must be worn under other clothing. Leggings are not to be worn alone.
- No jeggings, yoga pants, tight, or form-fitting bottoms.
- No pajama pants or tops.
- Coats, jackets, backpacks, purses, headphones, earbuds, blankets, and stuffed animals are to be kept in lockers during the school day.
- Hats, sunglasses, armbands, and gloves are to be kept in lockers during the school day.
- Bandanas of any color are not to be worn or brought to school. They will be confiscated.
- Writing/markings on self or others, or writing/markings on own clothing or other's clothing is not allowed.
- Clothing, buttons, jewelry, or other items which contain vulgar words or pictures, or identify/promote alcohol, tobacco, illegal substances, weapons, or sexual content are not allowed and will be confiscated.
