

Cleveland Traditional College and Career Magnet Dress Code Policy 2023-2025

SHIRT OPTIONS:

Colors are red, white, navy blue and light blue

- *Long or short sleeves (no sleeveless)
- *Solid colors only
- *Have a collar
- *No logos (other than CTM logos)
- *No rips/holes
- *Polo or oxford style
- *Shirt must be tucked in at all times

PANTS/DRESS OPTIONS:

Colors are navy blue, khaki (tan) and black

- *Pants, tailored shorts, skorts, or jumpers
- *Leggings may only be worn under skirts/jumpers
- *No rips/holes
- *Shorts may be worn under skirts/jumpers as long as they are not visible beneath the hemline
- *Shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers must be longer than mid-thigh

SPIRIT DAYS:

Thursday—Think College Thursdays

- *Any college shirt/sweatshirt/hoodie may be worn with uniform pants

Friday—School Spirit Days

- *Cleveland t-shirts/sweatshirts may be worn with uniform pants or jeans

LAYERING OPTIONS:

Colors are red, white, navy blue or light blue

- *Sweaters, sweatshirts, turtlenecks
- *Undershirts must be same colors
- *Non-uniform coats/jackets/sweaters/sweatshirts may only be worn in the classroom if they are solid color with no logos/designs/writing (other than CTM jacket)

SHOES/SOCKS/BELTS/HATS:

Students may choose their sock color as long as there are no inappropriate designs.

Closed-toe, closed-heel shoes only. Tennis shoes are best.

- *No heeled shoes or wedges

Belts are optional as long as pants stay up

No hats/caps (headbands are allowed unless they are a distraction and disrupt the learning environment)

AVOID:

Printing or logos (other than CTM logos) anywhere on clothing

No sweats or overalls

No oversized/sagging, or extremely tight clothing

No make-up or dangling earrings may be worn

Extreme hairstyles are to be avoided, especially if they interfere with the learning environment

Hoodies may be worn, but hood must stay off in school

OTHER: Clothing should be neat, clean and of proper length and size (BOE Policy 1473). Scout uniforms may be worn on troop/den meeting days. Spirit days and field trips may alter the dress code for special occasions.

Administration will have the final say regarding any and all dress code concerns.
