### Math—Ms. Johnson



Math 6 students will begin their work with negative numbers and make connections to the opposite side of the number line. We will also complete work on the coordinate grid- including all four quadrants of a coordinate plane. Math 6+ students are taking their work a step farther and are beginning work with the statistical problem-solving process. Students will learn steps that include how to formulate questions, collect and analyze data, and how to interpret results. Families can support students by approaching all problem solving SLOWLY.
