

“Look Mom no hands!!”



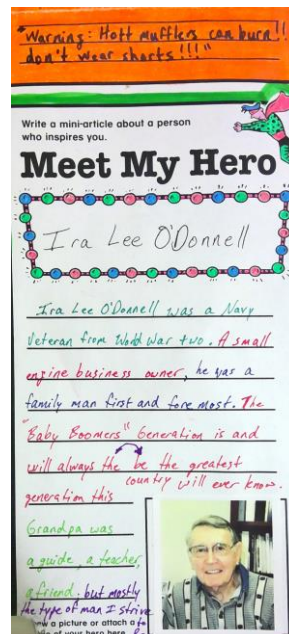
Mr. O'Donnell info:
