How Can My Student Make Up A Class?

- **Extended Learning Opportunity (ELO):** If a student ends the semester with a 50-59% (high F), they can take advantage of ELO. They are allowed to complete extra work to move up to a 60% (grade of D) which is passing. Core classes only.
- **Retake the course:** Student can repeat the class during the school year if they have room in their schedule.
- **Summer School:** Students can repeat the class during the summer (up to 1 credit) total.
- **Learning Center:** Students can repeat the course using an online program called Edgenuity. This can be done as a class during the day and students can also work on Edgenuity classes outside of school .Juniors and Seniors only.
