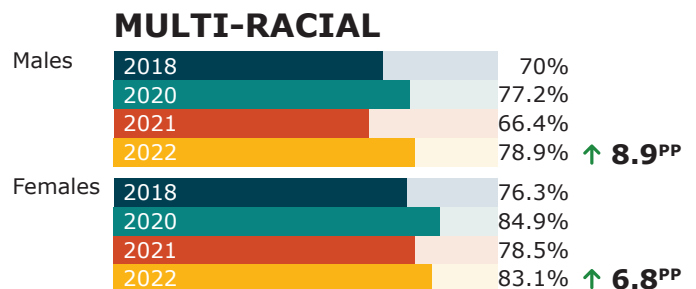
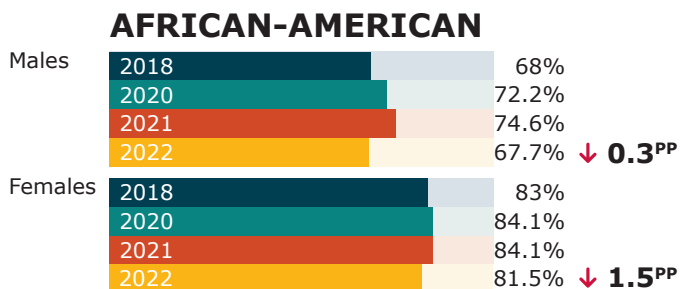
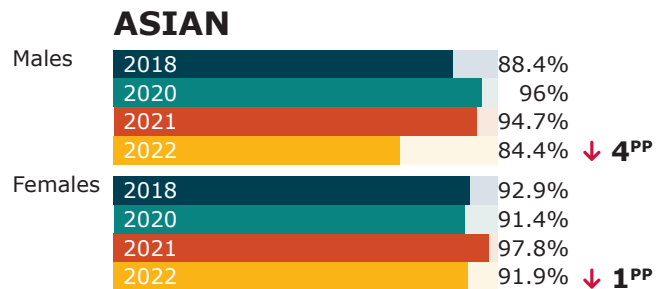
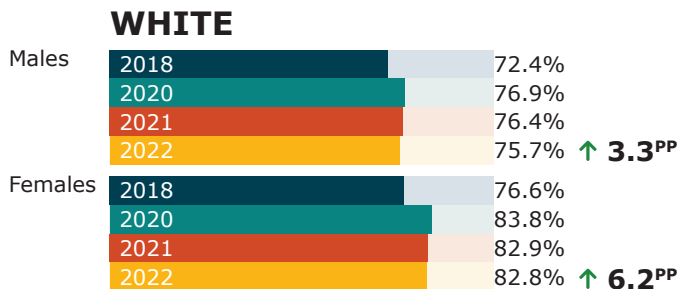
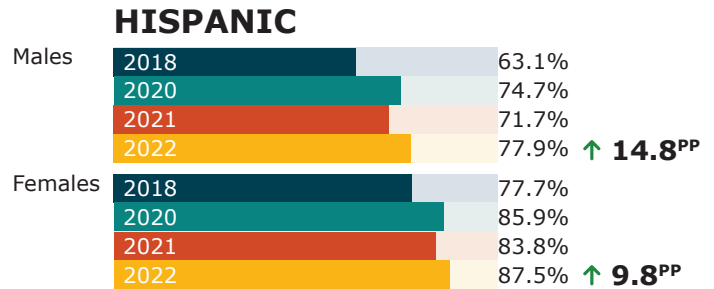
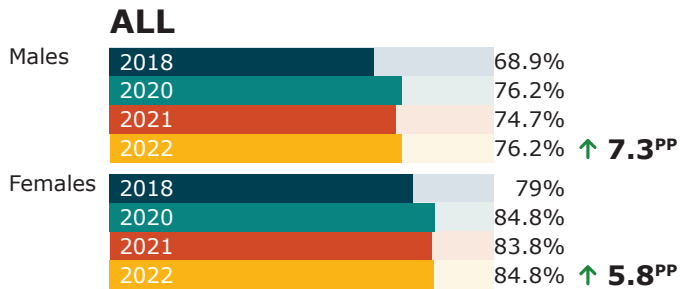
IN THE WICHITA PUBLIC SCHOOLS
