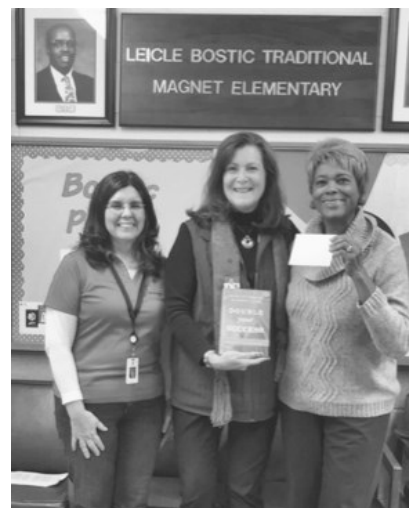

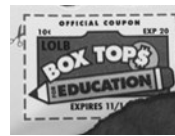
Box Top DO's and DO NOT's

- DO write your child's name on the sheet or baggie.
- DO turn Box Tops in each month (even it's only a couple).
- DO cut around the Box Top before attaching.
- DO use the Box Top app.
- DO check products for Box Tops before throwing away or recycling.
- DO ask Grandparents, neighbors, coworkers, and friends to save Box Tops for you.
- DO sign up at www.btfe.com and enter the sweepstakes.
- DO contact the Box Tops parents, Ashwini or Sarah if you have questions.

- DO NOT send expired Box Tops.
- DO NOT attach more than the sheet allows (10,25,50). Use an extra sheet or a baggie.



- DO NOT attach Bonus Box Tops to the sheet. Send loose in the envelope or a baggie.
- DO NOT turn in torn Box Tops. We need the expiration date & acronym.



*Remember expired Box Tops do NOT count towards the students total and we do NOT get money for them!
