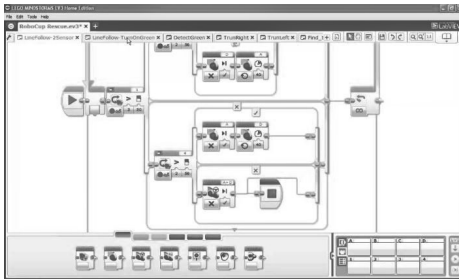
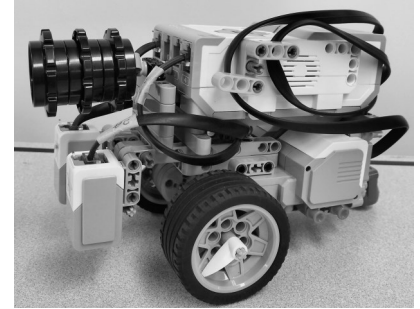

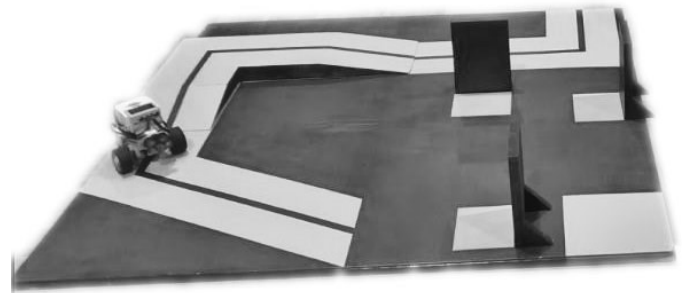
Stop in to cheer on our Bostic robotics teams:
