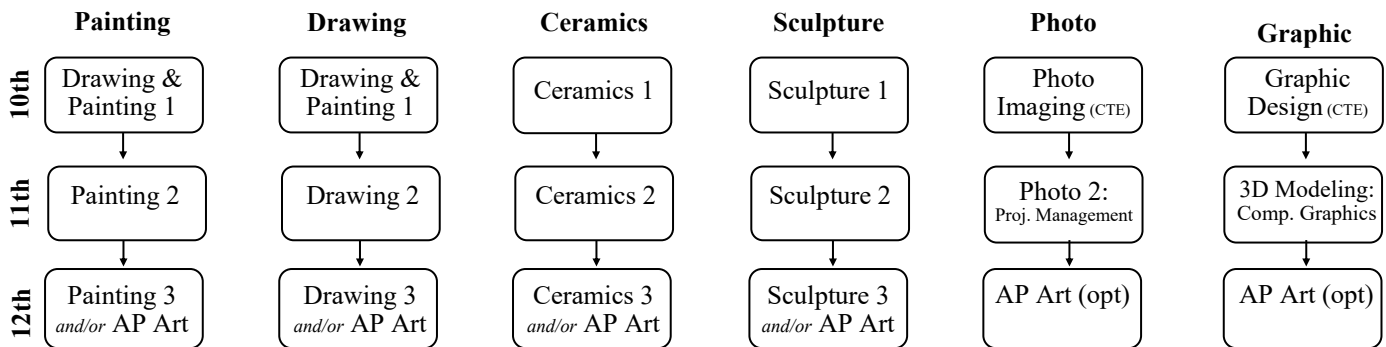

To earn the visual arts magnet certificate students must earn 6.5 visual art credits, with at least two credits from their concentration, earn 25 total credits, with all art classes and yearly projects completed with a 'C' or better, and a cumulative GPA at least 2.5.
