The state of Kansas is providing a free testing opportunity for ALL freshmen at Heights High School during the school day on February 25<sup>th</sup>. The Pre-ACT is being offered on February 25<sup>th</sup>. Regardless of the learning model the district is utilizing at the time of the exams, we will plan to administer the exams for any freshman who has an interest. Please know that we will do everything we can to keep students socially distanced and wearing masks the entire time they are in the building. Transportation will be provided by the district for any student who needs a ride to and from school.

Our goal is to have all freshmen participate in the Pre-ACT on February 25<sup>th</sup>, however with the current situation and safety concerns we understand if you would rather your student **not** participate. If you choose **not** to send your student, they will have an asynchronous learning day.

Opting out of the testing will not negatively affect a student's grade, nor will it affect the high school opportunities students have for participation in a full range of academic programs and services.
