

WPS COVID Case Protocol FOR STAFF, STUDENTS AND VISITORS

HOUSEHOLD CONTACT

Individual lives in the same household as a person who has tested positive for COVID-19

Asymptomatic AND Fully Vaccinated or Tested Positive for COVID in the Past 90 days

Individuals that are asymptomatic AND are fully vaccinated or have tested positive for COVID in the past 90 days can continue to attend work/school. The individual should monitor symptoms daily for 5 days after positive case is released from isolation. It is recommended, but not required, that a mask be worn during this time. Should symptoms arise, you should follow the directions in the "Experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms" column of the [WPS COVID Case Protocol](#).

Not Fully Vaccinated or Has Not Tested Positive for COVID in the Past 90 days

Individuals that are not fully vaccinated or have not tested positive for COVID in the past 90 days may attend school/work as long as they are asymptomatic and consent to daily rapid antigen testing through day 10. It is recommended, but not required, that a mask be worn during this time.

Individuals that do not consent to daily testing, must quarantine at home along with the positive person for their isolation period, which is a minimum of 5 days (because exposure is considered ongoing within the house) and then an additional 5 days after the household contact has come out of isolation.

Individual DOES experience symptoms during quarantine period

Individual tests POSITIVE for COVID-19
