Dear parents and guardians,

I'm reaching out to let you know of a change that will occur at all of our Greater Wichita Athletic League football games in order to create the safest-possible game day environment for all of our student athletes and musicians, as well as spectators.

Beginning immediately:

- High school student attendance will be limited to students from the two competing schools. All students must have their students ID available in order to be admitted to the game, and
- Middle and elementary students must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Students may NOT be dropped off at the game to attend without a responsible adult present. Middle school students will also be expected to present their ID.
- Parents may continue to attend with no changes to our guidelines.

We know you join us in expecting our football games to be filled with competition, school spirit and fun, while at the same time being as safe as possible for all involved.

- Admission will be determined by the security team at the gate
