<p>Reading-We are reading narrative stories and learning about the story's characters, setting, and plot. We are also working on decoding multiple syllable words by breaking them into syllables.</p> <p>Math- We are learning how addition is related to multiplication. We are learning how to multiply using arrays, number bonds, and tape diagrams (pictures).</p>	<p>Reading- We are working on describing a narrative with details (characters, setting, beginning, middle, end) and point of view (who is telling the story). We are also working on writing our own narrative, especially focusing on vivid details, transitions and order.</p> <p>Math- We have been working on place value and patterns that go with that. We are transitioning to comparing numbers and rounding up to the millions place.</p> <p>You can help at home by reading together and asking questions about what is happening. Also, when you see numbers ask students to read them to you.</p>

# 5th Grade

Reading- In reading, we are working on analyzing narratives, generating narratives and analyzing language.

Math- We began the year by reviewing multiplication. We are working on place value and have added reading and writing decimal place value to the thousandths place.
