

Safe Arrival & Departure for ALL Students at Park Elementary School

Safety is our #1 priority, so we have developed arrival and dismissal procedures to ensure that all students can get to school and leave school safely. Beginning Monday, October 26, we will no longer be taking students' temperatures as they arrive. We ask that families do those screenings at home before coming to school. Due to this change we have revised our arrival procedures as follows.



Revised Arrival Procedures

- Arrive between 8:50-9.
- If arriving in a car, drive up in the curbside drive-up lane. *Please do not park and unload.* The only exception to this is for families with PreK students.
- ***Students must remain in vehicles until the vehicle is summoned past the cross-walk by school personnel and given the signal to unload.*** The only exception to this is for families with PreK students.
- Students should have masks on and belongings gathered so they are ready to unload when it is their turn.
- Once students exit their cars, they should enter the building through the assigned door and proceed to class. (Grade levels have designated doors to use for arrival/dismissal.)
- Students who walk from home or ride bicycles should not arrive prior to 8:50.

We will continue to allow students into the building only 10 minutes before school starts, except for students who are in morning latchkey, and breakfast will be available at that time. Please keep students in vehicles and don't drop off your students early because we won't have adult supervision or a place for them inside our building.

We have carefully planned our arrival procedures to allow for appropriate social distancing and to prevent overcrowding on our campus, and we are very appreciative of your support in implementing our plan!
