Enroll by April 9!

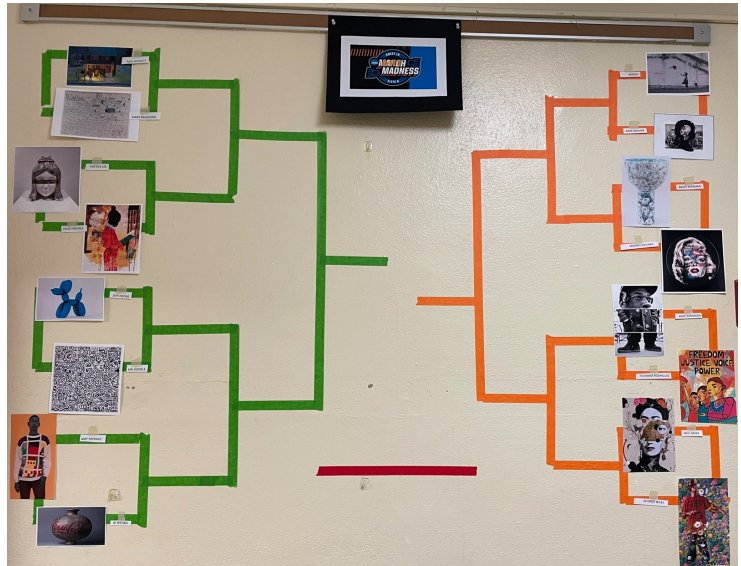
Art News at Riverside!

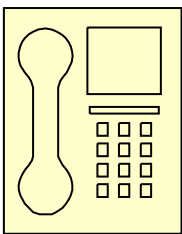
