Classroom Tips & Tricks

A fun improv game, this helps students concentrate on what others are saying and practice thinking fast on their feet.

Students form a circle. One student starts by saying a word, any word. The student sitting next adds another random word, which does not have to be connected to the first word. For instance, the first student says 'spaghetti' and the second says the word 'book.' The third student in the circle has to immediately come up with a definition statement, which includes the two words just mentioned. The student can come up with anything, as long as it is fun and creative. A fun sentence could be something such as "Spaghetti has recently been declared as one of the most delicious forms of bookmark that any book lover could use, especially while reading during a meal."

You can also change the order and pick any two people at random to say the words and a third random person to come up with the definition.
