

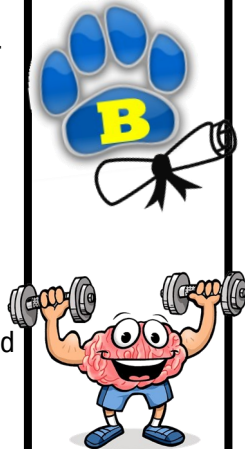
WELCOME!

EVERY DAY "STUFF"

- Please review the ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL document for information regarding our safe drop-off and pick-up plan. We will have 3 Curb Zones and a Waiting Tree.
- All doors are locked during the school day. Please use the doorbell at Door #1 for entry during the day.
- During Arrival and Dismissal, please do not park along Woodchuck Street. Students should not be crossing parking lots or roadways to meet you.
- Regular school attendance is extremely important to help children become successful in school. When a student is unable to attend school, please call the office at (316) 973-3300. Please leave the student's name, teacher's name and reason for being absent.
