

HIGH SCHOOL INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITY ELIGIBILITY

Wichita Public Schools is a member of the Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA). Eligibility in interscholastic activity programs is based on guidelines outlined in the KSHSAA handbook (which includes middle school) found at www.kshsaa.org.

ELIGIBILITY FOR INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITY PROGRAMS

- **Students must meet eligibility criteria in order to participate in interscholastic activity programs.**
- Students must pass five courses the semester **prior** to the interscholastic activity program.
- During the semester of the interscholastic activity program, students must be enrolled in a minimum of five courses and be a student in good standing.
- Individual schools may define “good standing” and determine additional eligibility criteria.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR PASSING A COURSE

- **At the end of a grading period in courses using standards-referenced grading (SRG), scores will be converted to a letter grade using the district-adopted conversion chart.**

Conversion to Letter Grades

3.00-4.00	=>	A
2.50-2.99	=>	B
2.00-2.49	=>	C
1.01-1.99	=>	D
0.00-1.00	=>	F



- Students must score, at minimum, a letter grade of D in order to pass a course using SRG.
- A few courses will not use the standards-referenced grading system. These courses are considered pass/fail courses. Students in these courses must meet the individual criteria outlined in a course syllabus to obtain a passing score.
