

Federal Income Chart for Child Nutrition Program Benefits Effective from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023

Your children may qualify for reduced price or free meals if your household income falls within the limits on this chart. Gross income is the amount you earn before taxes and other deductions are taken out.

IMPORTANT: If you receive income with a variety of pay frequencies (such as monthly and every two weeks), convert each income source to an annual amount. Multiply the gross amount by the number shown for each pay frequency: Weekly X 52, Every 2 Weeks X 26, Twice a Month X 24, Monthly X 12

Add all the converted income amounts and round the total to the nearest whole dollar. Finally, compare the total and household size to the yearly amount.
