- Is self-motivated and self-disciplined
- Is willing and cooperative in working with others
- Will seek help from teachers when necessary
- Is articulate and writes well
- Will cheerfully provide service to the community
- Is involved in extracurricular activities
- ♠ Earns above-average grades

- Has shown an ability to persevere in the face of obstacles
- Has excellent study habits and organizational skills, and manages time well
- Will participate in class positively and willingly on a regular basis
- Attends school regularly and makes up work promptly when absent
- Possesses good critical thinking skills (can synthesize, reason, see relationships, draw conclusions, deduce, infer, etc.)
- Has a universal attitude (should have a broad range of interests: academic and aesthetic)
