IB Coordinator Report

- 1. Steve Shook will look into establishing IB as an independent organization for fund raising purposes. Tats Shepherd mentioned opportunities for tapping 10% of 100,000 State Farm Drive???. Vendors offering 20% of sales, such as Mike's Wine Dive were discussed.
- 2. Students and parents of Class of 2015, Class of 2016, Class of 2017, Class of 2018 can sign up to get one way texts from school on **REMIND.COM** to get timely reminders and important notification. The IB office staff (Mr. Shook, Mr. Boykins, and Mrs. Sayler) will use this tool along with fusion web page to notify significant events or deadlines.
- 3. Steve Shook will look into ways of unsubscribing to school e-mails and texts once a student graduates.

- 4. Hall Pass for all visitors: a new district measure to keep kids safe from sexual predators. All visitors register at the office to get a sticker. Frequent visitors/volunteers can get key fob by showing government issued id at the office across from attendance office. Parents that are in briefly to drop off lunches are not required to register in the office. Parents coming in for IEP meetings, IBPA meetings and other long sessions will require a hall pass.
- 5. IB Key Chain: School has 40 key chains remaining from last year. Board had approved \$400 last year to order key chains with a new logo, money has not been spent yet. Current treasurer re-approved \$400 as an initial estimate to order new key chains with new logo. Final price is to be determined.
- 6. Tina has sent a message to teachers to request items needed.
- 7. Steve Shook will have a write up in the next newsletter addressing parents of Junior and Senior students. He will share information about exam registration, forms, and fees. Parents will be able to put money in layaway for IB exams, which is refundable if a student chooses to leave IB.
