The **Wichita Junior Golf Association** also has Junior Golf at the courses. I have not been involved in this since my son graduated from high school but Sim has a pretty good program. This is on Monday or Tuesday mornings depending on the course. Mostly just playing and little instruction where the First Tee stuff in the evenings is mostly instruction/practice. All of the beginner sections at Auburn Hills is full. Since your kids have played HS Golf, they should be able to go into the players program this year. Sim Park still has spots open. The first day they usually do an evaluation then place them in the appropriate class based on performance.

If you have Freshmen girls and boys they really need to do either the First Tee or do the Monday morning at Sim Park. If they play high school golf for four years and do the Junior Golf they are eligible for \$10,000 scholarships thru the Augie Navarro Foundation. I have had two players win this scholarship as well as my son. They give out about 10 of these each year. Completely worth the time!

There is also a “**Players Tournament Series**” offered thru Wichita Golf. They have 9 or 18 hole tournaments on Sunday afternoons all summer. The link is below and super affordable. \$10 a tournament. Link for that is below.
