A) Grant Requests:

- 1) Purchase 8 copies of <u>How to be Irresistible to Colleges</u> to complete a classroom set (\$76.67) from Mr. Boykins, school counselor. Mr. Boykins and Ms. Hutton use the book with the IB juniors for college prep. The book is no longer in print.
- 2) Membership fee and access to the American Psychology Association (APA) (\$189) from Ms. Archibold, IB Psychology teacher and EE coordinator. Allows IB Psychology and IB EE students to access the APA database for research work.
- 3) Dinner expense for Extended Essay "Bootcamp" work sessions (\$250 max) from Ms. McHenry & Ms. Archibold, organizers and hosts of EE "Bootcamps". Students can work on their extended essays and get help with research, expectations and develop a strategy to accomplish their EE plan. There are two sessions in March. Pizza, cookies and water are provided for the after school sessions that 20-30 students attend. Food and drinks are purchased based on the number of students who RSVP.
