* **Participate**, following **Future Ready Return to School Plan** guidelines and KSHSAA activities and return to participation guidelines, including social distancing and face masks. Academic class-based activities are dependent on learning model status.

****Restricted** participation, all conditions for “Participate” plus the following WPS expectations:

- During the season of the sport/activity, and for two weeks following, the student would agree to participate in school via the MySchool Remote learning model.
- Student would achieve all grading and attendance expectations for student participants.
- Student would participate in academic tutoring or other intervention strategies as may be recommended/expected to support academic success.
- Student and coaches would commit to upholding recommended personal hygiene strategies – including social distancing, wearing face masks, washing hands often – to minimize public health risk.
