How to Participate on MS Teams with Interpreter Access





CAMERA ON

1. Open your MS Team Channel 
2. Turn on the camera  to utilize the support of your Video Remote Interpreter when you would like to interact with teachers and classmates using sign language to communicate.
3. The Video Remote Interpreter (hearing) is able to unmute/mute to support sign-to-voice & voice-to-sign interpreting





RAISE HAND

1. Open your MS Team Channel 
2. Click “raise-your-hand” 
3. When your hand is recognized, you can either turn on your camera or use the chat to communicate.



REAL-TIME CHAT

1. Open your MS Team Channel 
2. Click on the CHAT icon 
3. When your chat response is recognized, you can continue to interact through chat or turn on your camera to communicate.
