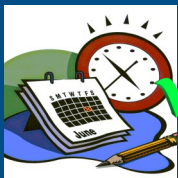

Learning from Home

The 2020-2021 school year has offered us a new opportunity for students to learn from the safety of their own homes. Here are a few of the notable characteristics of My School Remote (MSR).



Daily Schedule

Students will follow the same instructional block schedule as their peers on-site, including Specials and reading groups.

Students will be logged in with other students and their teacher via Microsoft Teams, able to interact, ask questions, receive assistance, and turn in assignments for each course.



Aligned curriculum

Students in MSR will be learning the same grade level standards and using the same curriculum as students on-site, keeping them on the same learning pace as everyone else. They will use a combination of digital and material media to complete their assignments.



Individual Devices

Students will be assigned a personal device to access their learning from home. Kindergartners will get iPads, 1st-5th graders will get Chromebooks.

Supplies

- ◆ Students will be using a combination of technology and traditional materials for My School Remote Learning

Technology

- ◆ Students will need to log in to Microsoft Teams on their device daily for attendance and instruction. The Teams app can be located through the student's Rapid Identity Portal page.
- ⇒ Students will not necessarily be in front of their screens for the entire day.
- ⇒ Kindergartners will be using the iPad as their device.
- ⇒ 1st-5th graders will be using Chromebooks

- ⇒ Teachers can be contacted by district email address, district phone number, and now answer calls through Microsoft Teams

Setting

- ◆ Find a comfortable seat at a table or desk.
- ◆ Set a daily schedule or visual calendar for students to structure their day.
- ◆ Reduce noise in the area that the student will be working.

Attendance

- ◆ Teachers will take attendance daily
- ◆ Students are accountable to the time frames that align to the daily schedule
- ◆ If students are not able to attend their sessions, the school must be notified following normal procedures.

Music

- ◆ MSR Music class will sing, dance, listen, create, play, and learn through a wide variety of musical activities and experiences.
- ◆ Students will submit personal performances and creations through Microsoft Teams, Flipgrid, and SeeSaw to share their musical skills with Ms. Garvey and Mr. Burgess.



PE

- ◆ Students will log in for PE twice a week! Please have a small area where they can safely move around and ready to go.
- ◆ We will be working on fun activities to do at home to stay healthy and active.
- ◆ There will be times when they will need to find equipment at home for PE class (e.g. stuffed animals, socks, towels, or even string).

Art

- ◆ Students will work on various visual art projects throughout the year from home, instructed and guided by our teacher online.
- ◆ They will use a combination of some school provided materials as well as supplies from home.

Library

- ◆ At this time, students will not be able to check out books from our library.
- ◆ WPS has partnered with Wichita Public Library to provide the resources available through their public library, including free E-Books.



Specialized instruction and support

- ◆ Students with IEPs, ILPs, and 504s will be supported.
- ◆ IEP and 504 teams will work with parent/guardians to discuss IEP needs based on the students' selected learning model.
