Health Check

Please make sure your student is not feeling ill or exhibiting any symptoms. **If they have symptoms of, have tested positive for, or are awaiting test results for COVID-19, DO NOT send your child to school, and please call your child's school to report a COVID-related absence.**

Gear

Don't forget your cloth mask and refillable water bottle (plastic face shields may be worn in addition to, but not in place of, a face mask). Bring in your supplies labeled with your name. Also, bring your backpack and lunch or lunch money. Follow applicable student dress codes.

Arrival

Campuses will share their drop-off procedures and start times with families. Please make sure your student has their mask on. **No parents/guardians will be allowed to exit their vehicles or walk into the building.** Thank you for understanding this is for everyone's safety. Students will enter, have their temperature checked, be able to grab a breakfast and go directly to their class. Students who ride the bus will need to wear a mask on the bus and will have their temperature checked as they exit the bus.

Daily Routines

Students will remain in their classroom, but they will have outdoor recess (weather permitting) and other opportunities to move around and remove face masks for short breaks. Art, music and PE teachers will visit classrooms regularly.

Navigating

Staff will be stationed around the building helping students get to classes and find their way. We know they're nervous, and may have never been here before, and we promise we'll take good care of them.

Meals

Students may bring their lunch, or they may purchase boxed options for a Grab and Go Meal to eat socially distanced in the cafeteria(s).

Dismissal

Make sure your student knows how they are getting home. We will have a controlled release to ensure social distancing. Campuses will share specific dismissal times. When you arrive home, wash hands and immediately wash or set aside to wash worn cloth face coverings.
