## EXPERIENCING COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

Individual is having symptoms of COVID-19 but has not yet been confirmed negative or positive

### ✓ STAY HOME AND GET TESTED

- ✓ Contact your school or work site to notify of absence. Call 973-4790 to schedule free testing.

#### COVID-19 Symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4F or greater
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills or shivering
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea



## CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASE

Individual tests positive for COVID-19

- ✓ Excluded from on-site school and work with earliest return on day 6 (symptom day is day 0)
- ✓ Isolate at home for a minimum of 5 days **AND**
- ✓ Remain fever free for 24 hours without medication, **AND** have resolving/no new symptoms
- ✓ Continue to wear a mask through day 10

Call your school or work site to confirm positive case and make any necessary arrangements.

## CLOSE CONTACTS

As of 1/18/22, KDHE has allowed schools to suspend identifying susceptible close contacts exposed to COVID-19 and any potentially exposed individuals will not be notified. It is the responsibility of individuals/families to monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 and stay home when ill.

**USD 259 will continue to offer COVID-19 testing for staff, students, and their families at AMAC (903 S Edgemoor) by appointment only.** Please call (316) 973-4790 to schedule.

**Schools will continue to offer COVID-19 testing in the building as needed** for staff and students who develop symptoms during the school day. Students will need testing consent on file.
