





On the Assessments landing page, select Progress

**Progress Monitoring** 

The Progress Monitoring Page is broken up into three sections.


- Percentage of recently assessed students in each type of progress category by assessment. (Hovering over the visual will display the student count within each percentage.)
- 2. Students assessed within the range given in number 4. Summary details can be exported in excel
- **3.** Specific Assessment Details by student that can be exported into excel.
- **4.** The Days Ago Last Assessed slider will allow users to narrow down the window by which the student/s were last assessed. Changing the day range within the slider will affect the data show within the entire dashboard.




**Filters:** Filters are found along the left side of the page. These filters will allow users to narrow their search to specific data. The filters on this page will apply to all three datasets. For example. Selecting only the 5th grade in the grade filter will change the data to reflect only fifth grade students within all three data sets. Additional filters for Assessment Name, Teacher and School are found across the top and will also apply to all three data sets.

From the Assessments Landing Page click on FastBridge Growth Score Cards.




From the FastBridge Scorecards Landing Page select MTSS Model



The Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) Model gives an overview of the percentage of students within each tier, aligned to the MTSS Triangle. (Tier 1 = 80% CP & Low Risk; Tier 2 = 15% Some Risk, Tier 3 = 5% High Risk.)

Use the filters to focus the data by grade level, testing period and assessment.





Click into the report to lock in the ellipsis, then click on the ellipsis and select export data. Choose Summarized Data from the export menu and click on Export.



This will export the data into Excel. Use the filters to filter the data by; Grade Level, Progress Monitored = Blank, aReading, and aReading Most Recent Risk Level = someRisk & highRisk, CBMR-English Most Recent Risk Level = someRisk & highRisk.



This will generate a list of current students in the grade level needing reading intervention and Progress Monitoring.
