<u>Minutes:</u> A motion (Flores/Blessant) to approve the May minutes was approved without opposition.

<u>Treasurer's report:</u> Treasurer Anthony Vo reviewed year ending report 2021. Contributions were \$2,093 and expenses were \$2,508, deficiency of \$415. Contributions were the lowest they've been in years. Expenses were also one of the lowest in years. Noticed on the expenses that the pending Chemistry expense was not in the list of expenses for the year. Talk to Paula about tracking down where that invoice was paid from. New Business:

Kids showing up at the normal time will have guidance and be able to have general uses. Also, breakfast and lunches are free this year!

<u>IB Space</u> – IB put a lot of effort into creating a space for IB students. The space has white boards, desks, chairs, and bean bags. Will open up in the morning and at lunch to students. Teachers can also use it for overflow use during class times. It is across from the English Classrooms.

Freshman Representative -

Still in need of two people to service as Freshman Representatives. 6 names were polled. Esau Freeman and Sara Ornelas were voted in to be reps.

<u>Community Service Hours</u> – Mrs. Gutierrez will be getting with students to look at the component of the service project and not the hours. (Question Asked by a Freshman Parent)
