






HISTORY OF NORTHEAST MAGNET HIGH SCHOOL

Northeast Magnet High School for science and art opened in 1990 as the first magnet high school in Wichita with 395 students. The school provided specialized programs in science and visual arts. Magnet projects utilizing technology, block scheduling, college prepemphasis, and smaller learning committees were significant innovations. In 1996 NEM merged with the Downtown Law Magnet program.

In 1990 the students selected the school colors to be navy blue and silver. The Griffin was chosen as the mascot to represent the two distinct elements of art and science as represented by the lion and the eagle. United Way, spirit week, magnet mania, magnet day, project fairs, and senior show have been significant events throughout the years that have built strong school traditions.



In August 2012 NEM moved to a new state-of-the-art building. As part of this move the schools colors were changed to purple and silver. This change reflects the overall design of the new building while holding the tradition of the Griffin mascot.

NEM has been recognized by the US Department of Education as a "New American High School", the James Institute for Effective schools, the Senatorial Award for Excellence in Art, and US News & World Report as the top high school in South-Central Kansas. The students of NEM have consistently performed at very high levels on state and national assessments. Over 85% of any graduating class goes on to attend college. As a result of these and other accomplishments, NEM is considered one of the top high schools in the state and nation.
