

AVID - Secondary



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Overview

We can create more efficiency in the secondary master schedules by focusing resources (people, time, and money) to maximize student choice while minimizing cost.

- AVID elective courses offered at South, Truesdell, East, Mead, Robinson, North, Pleasant Valley, Heights, and Coleman.
- Guarantee middle schools with the AVID elective course begin in 2nd semester of 6th grade.
- Continue AVID Excel (language development support) at Mead, Pleasant Valley, and Coleman.
- Middle schools not listed would not offer the AVID elective in the 24-25 school year.
- High schools not listed would progress the class of 2027 through the AVID elective and then no longer have AVID elective classes.

Expected Outcomes

- Increase the number of students per section in the AVID elective from 18.47 in January 2024 to 30 in May 2027.
- Maintain enrollment in the AVID elective at 8% of all secondary students.
- Increase the retention of students in the AVID elective in high school from X% in May 2024 to Y% in May 2027.
