- One inch margins
- Header in upper right hand corner ½ inch from the top of page: your last name and page number (Insert—Page Number—right hand side—type in your last name before the little page number already provided and hit the space bar)
- Title is at one inch from top of page and centered: Works Cited
- <u>All</u> the text should be the same font (Times New Roman, Calibri, or Arial) and size (11 or 12 point)
- Entries are alphabetized by author's last name or title if no author
- First line of each entry is left aligned; all other lines in an entry are indented (press Tab)
- Double space the entire page—<u>no</u> extra spaces in between entries or in between the title and first entry
