



PIB School Supply List

Required Supplies

- Two **two-inch binders** (one for Language Arts and Math; one for Science, Social Studies, and Spanish.) **NO Three Inch or Zipper Binders as they do not fit in lockers.** All binders should have the following inside:
 - Loose-leaf paper (NOT spirals; place inside binder)**
 - 2-3 sets of 8 tab dividers (You may reuse dividers from previous years)
- Pencil case with the following inside to be carried to all classes:
 - Earbuds
 - Pens (blue, black, and red)**
 - Gel or non-smear highlighters**
 - Pencils**
 - Pencil-top eraser or large eraser**
 - Dry erase markers (thin-sized)**
 - Colored pencils **
 - TI-30XS Multiview Scientific Calculator (please put your name on it) (See order form).
- Graph-paper composition notebook for Math (will use 3 years; 7th & 8th graders use their composition book from previous years)
- (Optional) standard sized locker shelf

***These supplies frequently need to be replenished during the school year.*
